Belgian Strong Dark Ale, brownish amber in color, aroma of spices and notes of dark fruits

Allagash White – *Maine, 6%*

Belgian-style Witbier, light-bodied with ample carbonation, aromas of wheat, lemon, spice, and malt

Avery Brewing Maharaja Imperial IPA – *Colorado, 10.24%*

5/ 9 oz.

Tangy, vibrant and pungent, dark amber hue, hoppy, exquisite malt essence, intense grapefruit hop aroma

Bell's Amber – *Michigan, 5.8 %*

4/ 16 oz.

Dark orange color, flavors of caramel, grass, and citrus, aromas of malt and floral hops

Bell's Oberon – *Michigan, 5.8%*

Golden yellow, hints of apricot and citrus fruit, a nice fruit and malt balance

Bell's Two Hearted Ale – *Michigan, 7%*

Amber color, aromas of malt and slight hops, caramel and citrus undertones, the finish is dry and bitter

Duvel Single – *Belgium, 6.8%*

Yellow color, light carbonation, aromas of spices and floral hops, malt flavor and light bitterness

Firestone Union Jack IPA – *California, 7.5%*

Pale orange aromas of raisin and bread, hop bitterness with a malt balance

Goose Island En Passant – *Illinois, 4.5% Limited release*

English Mild Rye Ale, double fermented with blood oranges and Columbus hops

Great Divide Collete Farmhouse Ale – *Colorado, 8%*

A saison-style, big citrus aromas and a mild taste with nice carbonation

Amber ale with citrus-like fruity hops, slight flavor of malt and pine

Orange brown with a sweet aroma, flavors of banana, cherry, apple, and a bit of spice

Saison Dupont Belgian Farmhouse Ale – <i>Belgium, 6.5%</i> Gold-hued, spicy, grassy, and dry	8/ 12 oz.

Six Point Crisp Lager – <i>New York, 5.4%</i> Golden yellow, aromas of sweet malt, spicy, zesty hops, mild bitter finish	5/ 12 oz.

Southern Tier Hop Sun – <i>New York, 5.1%</i> Citric wheat beer, crisp, hoppy, bread flavors, mild malts and medium carbonation	5/ 12 oz.	
Stiegl Goldenbrau Lager – <i>Austria, 4.9%</i> Golden and hazy, flavors of sweet malt, light grass and hops, very crisp finish	5/ 12 oz.

Weihenstephaner Hefe Weissbier – <i>Germany, 5.40%</i> Unfiltered, aromas of ripe banana and clove, thick and foamy head, lively carbonation, rich wheat taste	7/ 22 oz.
